We are delighted to offer our Summer Camp program for 2026. We offer a 3-week program with an alternative schedule of 3 hours activities for those families who wish to leave their children for less periods of time in a Camp.

Our program offers a simple structure that makes it easy to families to visualize all activities in detail. We offer a three-hour camp schedule in the mornings from 9:00 am to 12:00 for young learners ages 3 to 6 and afternoons, ages 6 up to 12, for older students. Our classes are tailored to be age-appropriate, respecting children's physical needs and cognitive milestones. We focus in helping our students to reduce their stress levels and cope better with their emotions

To maintain the caliber of our instruction and the safety of our program, we utilize a flat-rate fee:

## Tuition Breakdown

To ensure a sustainable partnership and professional delivery, the tuition is allocated as follows:

- **30% Facility & Administration:** This portion is dedicated to the center and school to support the use of the space and local program coordination.
- **70% Program Operations:** This portion covers our core operational costs, including:
  - Certified lead teacher fees.
  - Comprehensive liability insurance.
  - Full compliance with all updated school and safety documentation.

## All-Inclusive Materials

There are no hidden costs, or equipment lists for parents to manage. The flat rate includes the use of all specialized props and materials required for complete somatic experience:

- **Movement Equipment:** Children's yoga mats, balance discs, and yoga straps.
- **Mindfulness Tools:** Breathing balls and sensory props to support neuro-physiological regulation.
- **Creative Supplies:** All miscellaneous materials required for the integrated arts and crafts portion of the curriculum.

**We request 50% payment immediately after contract signing, once enrollment closes.**

This is needed to invest in materials, yoga mats, and art supplies for our classes. Following our recent expansion, our multidisciplinary team is committed to supporting students and their families through our programs. They are all international professionals that need reignition to work with sustainability and tranquility.
